Subject: **Bal Harbour Police Department - Staffing Changes and New Appointment**

The purpose of this Letter to Council (LTC) is to inform you of various staffing changes in the Bal Harbour Police Department. I am pleased to announce that Carlos Arango will be joining our team and the Bal Harbour Police Department (BHPD) Command Staff as a Lieutenant effective June 18, 2018.

Carlos brings to our team 34 years of law enforcement experience, serving most recently as a member of the Doral Police Department Command Staff as Captain and Senior Executive Assistant to the Chief of Police. In this role, his responsibilities included supervising various administrative functions within the department, including payroll, finance, IT and communications, as well as overseeing the daily operations of the Office of the Chief.

As a founding member of the Doral Police Department, Carlos joined the Doral Police Department in 2008, and rose through the ranks. As a Sergeant, he was in charge of the Criminal Investigations Unit, where he was responsible for coordinating criminal investigations and supervising the activities of detectives, including those assigned to federal taskforces, as well as K9 officers and property and evidence clerks.

Prior to joining the Doral Police Department, Carlos served the Hialeah Police Department. During his tenure, Carlos was assigned to the Gang Investigations Unit, where he was an original member of the Miami-Dade County Multi-Agency Gang Taskforce. For over 10 years, Carlos was assigned to the Homicide Unit, managing complex criminal investigations.

With his vast experience in investigations and administration, Carlos will be a valuable asset to the Bal Harbour Police Department, where he will be assigned to supervise the Criminal Investigations Unit, oversee the Florida Commission for Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA) process and assist with the implementation of the Computer Aided

Dispatch (CAD) system.
